

Plummer Earns Perfect NFIB Voting Record On Small Business Issues

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EDWARDSVILLE — State Senator Jason Plummer (R-Edwardsville) has earned a 100% voting record from the National Federation of Independent Business (NFIB), Illinois' leading small business advocacy organization, for his consistent support of policies that help small businesses grow and succeed.

“Small businesses don’t need more red tape, higher costs, and mandates from Springfield.
