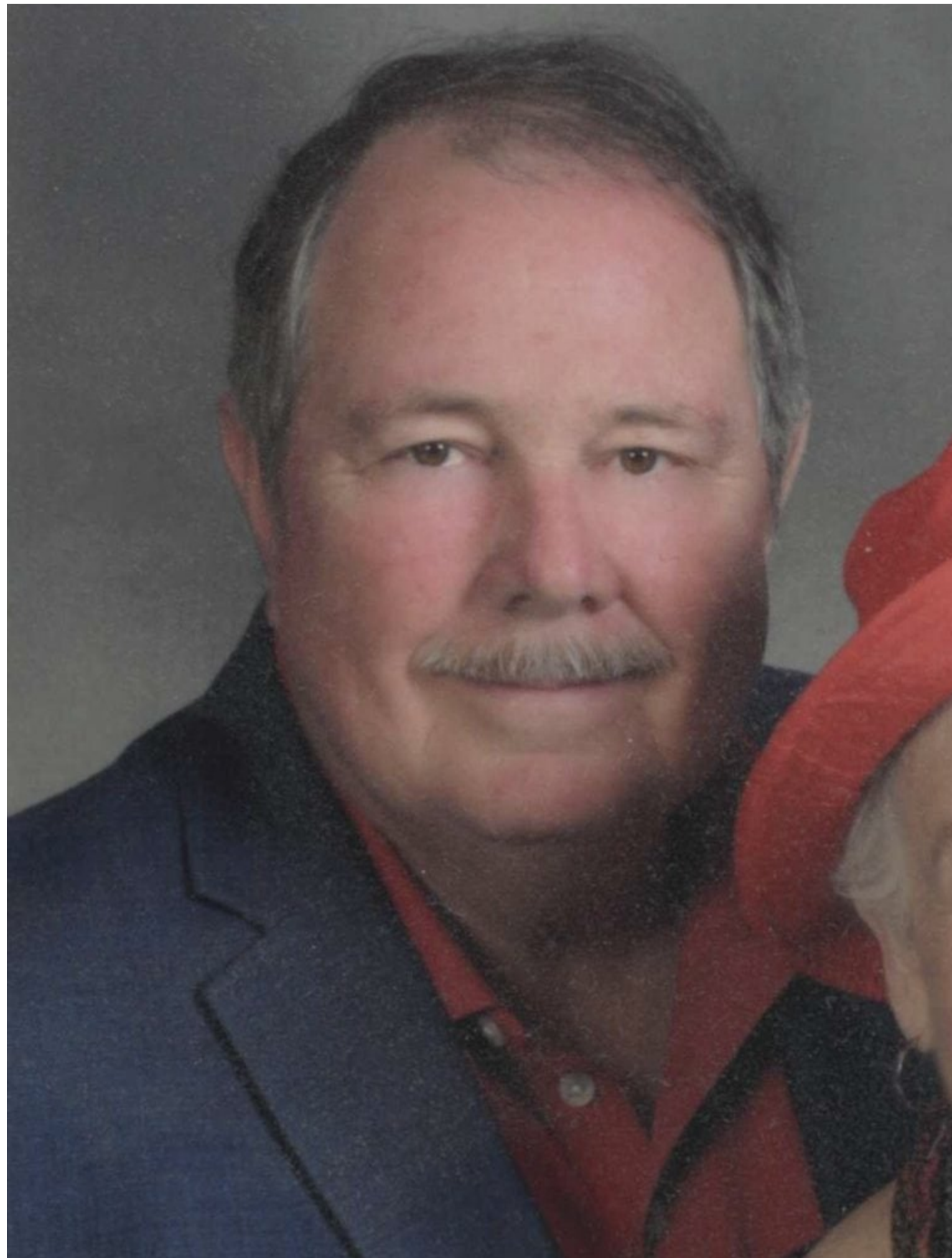


Dennis and Jan Reilly of Edwardsville Celebrate 60th Wedding Anniversary
